- We are pleased to announce a hybrid model for adult education! Classes will be in Heritage Hall and live stream via Zoom with a recording offered at a later time.
- Some speakers will be in-person and others will join us via Zoom. If our speaker joins us via Zoom, you are welcome to be in Heritage Hall and watch them on the big screen. HH will be one "screen" during those sessions.
- If you plan to attend in-person adult ed in Heritage Hall, all participants are required to wear masks and strongly encouraged to be vaccinated.
- No coffee or refreshments will be served. Feel free to bring your own.
- Volunteers are needed to help manage the live stream/Zoom platform. Training is provided. If you've started a Zoom call, you can manage the platform. If interested, please contact Noelle.
